We have a large farm/ clinic as well as an active ambulatory practice. Dr. Kloppe is board certified in theriogenology which he focuses on exclusively during the breeding season. The internship position can have a primary reproductive focus in the spring if the intern is interested in this field. This would include ultrasounds, mare & stallion breeding soundness exams, stallion collection, and embryo retrievals.

The reproductive season in Arizona typically starts in mid-February and runs through early July. Dr. Kloppe breeds over 150 mares at the clinic with fresh and frozen semen. We have multiple breeding stallions who stand at our clinic. Dr. Kloppe also does dozens of embryo retrievals. We foal-out mares at our clinic and perform a lot of routine & emergency neonatal work.

We also perform a lot of "general" equine medicine, lameness, and surgery with a specialty in dentistry. We have a large base of regular clientele in which we have a very strong client-oriented relationship with. Durango Equine has two ultrasound machines (both digital), two portable x-ray machines, three Powerfloats, two dental dremels, an upper-airway endoscope, and an in-house x-ray processor. We see a variety of equine breeds and disciplines. We perform elective surgeries including cryptorchids, hernia repair, eye enucleation, cryosurgery, urethral extensions, colpotomies, etc. We do not perform orthopedic, abdominal, or arthroscopic surgeries. Dr. Hendrix will be fully certified in acupuncture in the fall 2007.

We rotate emergency calls with another local three-doctor equine practice. All the doctors rotate emergency duty. The intern would rotate on-call duty. If needed, we offer housing for the intern.
